## **Ethiopia: 800 Years of Total Eclipse!**

History books recorded more or less accurately that from 1275 to 1991 with the exception of 17 years of interregnum ( 11 July 1871 - 10 March 1889) Ethiopia with 80 ethnic nationalities and their own distinctive cultures and languages was ruled by one single ethnic group, asserting and imposing its culture and language as a norm, over every other nationality compelling them all to conform to this single culture and adopt it as their own.

Conformity to a way of life alien to one's own self-identity does not come as a free choice but is extracted by socio-economic, military and political coercions.

Eight-hundred years of oppression is too long for oppressed nations in Ethiopia to bear.

Eight-hundred years, or even more, of successive rule by a single identity say in Germany may be tolerable as a German sees him/herself no different from other Germans be it culturally, psychologically and/or linguistically.

If on the other hand, you have a nation of diverse nationalities brought together by consensus or bruit force and one group asserts its will and desire, disregarding that of the others, it is colonialism pure and simple.

A rule by force is undoubtedly lethal for those at the receiving end, but it is also damaging to those who practice and imposed it on others. For a start it is self-deceiving to refer to such a nation as 'one nation or in unison' when it is a

fact that man, unbounded by rule of law and no less than a wild beast engaged in an existential battle for survival, will fight even his own kind.

Nations of mythomane characters leading an unstable citizenry crave the foraying and marauding of their neighbours by fomenting indefensible cases their unstable populace wildly accept and uphold in order to cover up their evil desire, immorality and lack of real integrity.

Instead of looking inward, assessing their internal deficiencies (material and creative) and sorting them out, they tend to externalize and blame others.

Such is the case of Eritrea. When in 1952 Eritrea joined Ethiopia, it was the Eritrean people who voted to join by popular vote, albeit there was a lot of dirty machinations on the part of the Imperial Court to entice and coerce Eritreans to join. But at the end of the day, if most Eritreans had a clear and genuine desire to stay away, no amount of palace intrigues could have stopped the wishes of the Eritrean people.

Come independence, Eritreans found themselves bound by their limbs, enslaved, caught between a rock and a hard place, desperate to sell their kidneys to frail Arab moguls in their attempt to free themselves from their own government of racketeers led by Isayas Afeworke. The clan that emerged in Ankobor is a doppelgänger. A certain local priest, Yekuno Amlak (10/8/1270 - 19/6/1285) conspired with a Gafat military commander called Malassay and Sultan Dil Gamis, sultanate of Shewa and overthrew Naakueto Lab, ending the reign of Zagwe Dynasty at the Battle of Ansata. The beginning of a genocidal plot that was fully realised a century later. The Shewa Ankoraties created the fortress prison of Geshen and Ambassel where progenies of emperors and kings were kept, checked as chickens are kept in coops to avoid cockerels fighting to death to claim the harem/hareem!

The most notorious of all, Amede Seyon I, arguably who claimed he was the son of Qedma Asgard in defense of his incestuous relation with Dijan Mogesa, concubine of Wedam Arad/ his father, invaded the land of Damot, Hadya, ifat and Bete-Isreal and wiped the people to dust, thereafter they never were able to sustain independence existence but subservient to anyone who assert power in the country they called Ethiopia, period!

Amede Seyon likewise dared to venture to bring Tigray led by Yaibika Izgi, under his full control against the wish if the people who called the invaders Halestiyitat/mixed race.

Amede Seyon set the first military base at a location between the sea and Wuha-Milash then know Mekela/ Φ λ/splitting, made of non-Tigrian troop, 600 years later Haileselassie endvoured to copy-cut, under his son Bahri-Segad 1328.

But such a reckless venture ends up in two ways: obliteration of the indigenous people as is the case of the Agawe and Qemants, or the resistance of the indigenous people. The kings and emperors that are nominally know as Amharas, right from Yekuno Amlak to Haileselassie, including their consorts were from Debre Berhan, Merha Bete, and Ankobor. Even Fasiledis, his father Susenyos and his grandfather Fasil were from Bulga, his mother, Wales Saale and his wife Shake Work were from Shewa (see table below).

There were no dignitaries from Gojjam and Begemeder that emerged to prominence during the 800 years of Showan aristocratic rule. This leaves one stipulating that there were no Amharas in Wollo, Gojjam and Begemeder. In fact, history records that the Ankoborites were forced to move north, sandwiched by the Oromos. In their move northwards, they were confronted by the Oromos and compelled to submit to the Oromo war lords.

Sarsa Dengel Menas move the centre of his seat from Showa to Begemder. He built the castle of Guzara in Enfraz near Lake Tana to evade the Oromo threat encircling Menze and Wollo. To smooth his way northward he engaged with Bahri Negus Yeshaq of Tigray whom he succeeded to kill in 1576

However as they migrated, the Amhara managed to eradicate many indigenous people. Menas Lenedegel (1559-1563) Fasiledas Susenyos (born 20/11/1603 ruled 1632-18/10/1667) Sealed the fate of the Shenashas, Bete Israelites, Benshanguls and the Agawe people in the Amhara quest to grab land and resources, with the aid of foreign powers by undergoing total metanoia and adopting the catholic religion - so much for integrity, it has never been the feat.
